## PROFILE OF AN EVANGELIST (SC) IN AN UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP

- 1. Chooses to live among the people (Incarnational).
  - a. Knows the people
    - 1) Knows the culture and worldview especially the bridges and barriers to the Gospel in a way to know how to adjust the church planting process to fit the particular culture (not a long process).
    - 2) Learns the Language (if not already known)
  - b. Shares their lives with the people Relational; Connects with people
  - c. Models a Christian lifestyle and family (If team then also Christian community)
- 2. Models how to make disciples and plant reproducing churches as a lifestyle. (See the Acts Church Planting Pattern)
  - a. Uses a culturally appropriate, reproducing biblical pattern
  - b. Models and Trains new believers to do the same and train others.
- 3. Mobilizes and Trains <u>like-minded</u> coworkers in the Body of Christ to do the same (the more culturally close the coworker the better).
  - a. Mobilizes massive amounts of prayer
  - b. Shares God's Vision and the need
  - c. Help them move on to and stay on God's Agenda (Spiritual Leadership) (Revival)
  - d. Endvisioning
  - e. Trains them to make disciples and plant reproducing churches (in a way that can be easily reproduced) (OJT)
  - f. Ensures that all segments of society are hearing the Gospel. (Abundant Gospel Sowing) (Intentionally getting to all areas)
- 4. Trains (or has other leaders train) and mentors each new church and especially their leaders how to multiply and deal with problems. (On-going Leadership Training) (This is done in such a way that it can be easily reproduced.) Problems always arise and may be multiplication issues, character issues, relationship issues, doctrinal issues, or cultural issues.
- 5. Trains and mentors leaders from this people group to be evangelists (SCs) for this people group and other people groups around the world. (Needs to be reproducing)
  - a. They understand and are using the basic principles of mentoring/coaching
- 6. Helps the new churches establish some type of network to overcome future problems and ensure multiplication of churches until every person in the people group has heard.
  - a. Helps the new churches establish prayer networks among the churches.
  - b. Helps the new churches establish on going training and mission sending without having to create hierarchy.
  - c. Helps the new churches establish a process to deal with problems. Making sure that Biblical DNA is maintained.
- 7. Stays focused on High Value Kingdom Agenda items. This would include being able to evaluate how effective you have been and how to say "No" to other good things.
